Therefore James is to spend this Saturday, September 24, 2004, with his father from 9:00a.m. to 6:00p.m.. Mrs. Gale is to take James to his father by 9:00a.m.. Mr. Griffin is to deliver James to his mother by 6:00p.m. the same day. Neither parent is to leave their car nor speak to the other parent.

It is also requested that both parents meet with the Special Advocate as soon as possible.

To keep all informed, a meeting is scheduled at James's school, Carver Elementary at 2:30, on Monday September 27. All are implored and requested to attend if at all possible. This is to include both attorneys if possible. This letter will be faxed or hand delivered to all parties personally.
